AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT (only applies to classes 1-42;46-82): EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR. WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP. SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. AHA Value Show Rules: All classes are to be conducted in accordance with the rules of AHA. Judging, class specifications, rules and conduct shall be in accordance with the current USEF Rulebook. All decisions made by the judge and/or show management are deemed final and cannot be protested.

Arabian Registration Papers (only for classes 1-42;46-82): Arabian and Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian horses one year of age or over must be registered or if under one year of age, be eligible for registry and

registration applied for. A copy of the registration papers for each horse entered in this show must be sent with entries. Copies of both registrations must be sent for horses being shown in both the Half-Arabian and Anglo-Arabian. Horses must be shown under their full registered name. (AR101)

Stabling: Permanent 12 x 12 stalls with dutch doors. Competitors are responsible for stall damage. Smoking is prohibited in stall and barn areas, may use the parking lot. Horses must not arrive prior to 4PM the day prior to the competition without permission from show management and must be off grounds 1 hour after the last ride until permission has been granted by show management.

Bedding: If required, bedding must be purchased on entry form, no initial bedding will be provided. Competitors may bring their own shavings and/or sawdust.

Directions: From Louisville:264-E to 64 E, from 64 E take 265 N, exit 30 anchorage peewee valley, turn right off exit. Second light turn right on Reamers Rd. 8/10th of a mile turn right after hill onto Reamers Lane. Go 2/10th of a mile then on gravel road with two red gates and Stonehurst sign on the right with two American flags turn right. You can or text this number if you need help 502.550.5631. GPS will not always take you to the farm entrance.

No Show: All ‘no shows’ that have not contacted the show office prior to first ride will be considered a scratch for the rest of the show and time slots may be filled.

Ride Times: Ride times and show updates will be posted at www.stonehurstridingcenter.com. It is the responsibility of the rider to inform show management of any time conflicts as soon as possible after receiving their ride times. The final class schedule will be posted and available at the show office.

Entry Cancellation/Refunds/Hazardous Weather/Acts of God/Emergencies: Refunds (except office fee) will be given only if submitted in writing either by mail or email prior to or on the closing date. No refunds for any reason after closing date unless you can find someone to take all your exact rides and ride times, then if so, entire entry fees minus office fee will be refunded. Management reserves the right to cancel any classes due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, accident, or emergency. Every effort will be made to reschedule. No refunds for cancellations due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, accidents, or emergencies.

Other: All dogs must be leashed and attached to a person or immovable object. All entries must include a negative Coggins report dated within one year of the show date Entries must be legible and include all signatures and copies of all required cards in addition to full payment.

Protective Headgear Rules for Dressage: From the time horses are officially admitted to the competition grounds including non-competing riders, riders on non-competing horses, and those competing in all dressage classes and tests, including Para-Equestrian, must wear protective headgear as defined by this rule and otherwise in compliance with GR801. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.

Warning: Under the Equine Activity Liability Act, each participant who participates in an equine activity expressly assumes the risks of engaging in and legal responsibility for injury, loss, or damage to person or property resulting from the risk of equine activities. Neither the Organizing Committee, show volunteers and staff, the facility or its owners will be responsible for any damage, injury, or loss to persons, horses, or property of exhibitors or spectators. All owners and competitors are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. They are therefore strongly advised to take out third-party insurance providing full coverage to participation in equestrian events at home and abroad and to keep the policy up to date.

Arenas: Indoor 20m x x60m sand competition arena with 1 large outdoor sand warm-up arena and one lungeing pen. All tests are in a standard arena-in case of overfill; show may elect to run classes in a short arena.

Food and beverages will not be available on the grounds. Please bring your own.

Show Management reserves the right to combine, split or cancel classes as entries warrant. Show management reserves the right to vary or add officials and refuse any entry for a cause. Show management reserves the right to make any changes deemed necessary for the safe and efficient conduct of this competition. **Show management reserves the right to limit dressage (including western dressage) and/or sport horse in-hand entries to two classes per horse if schedule requires.**

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded to sixth place for each class.

Prize Money: *High score prize money of \$30 will be awarded to the highest scoring in-hand horse and also to the highest scoring horse competing in a dressage test.*

TBA Classes: Any dressage (Fourth Level or below), sport horse in-hand class, sport horse under saddle class or western dressage class may be added with the approval of show management and payment of \$45 TBA class fee. Email show secretary to request approval.

Special Notes: Spectators are asked to stay six feet away from the competition arena perimeter. The next rider to enter the competition arena needs to be waiting outside the arena prior to their ride. The ring steward will call for each rider however the rider is responsible for being ready to enter the arena at the officially scheduled time. 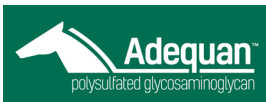

AHA ENTRY AGREEMENT

I have read the rules concerning competitions as printed in the Arabian Horse Association® (AHA®) Handbook and the Value Show Rules and agree to be bound by and subject to those Rules **and understand all decisions made by the judge are deemed final and can not be protested.**

AHA ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION

This document waives very important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

In consideration for AHA permitting me to participate in this Competition, and by signing the entry blank, I agree as follows:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, leasee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. **I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.**

I AGREE as a Horse Show Participant (or Parent/Guardian of Participant if a minor) to waive all claims which may otherwise arise from, including but not limited to infectious bacteria, viruses, fungi/mold, parasites or other agents which may be present at the Horse Show (and most other outdoor locations) and can cause infection in humans, as well as in animals.

I AGREE for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns to **release** AHA, the Competition, the facilities leased by the Competition and the owner(s) of the facilities, and all of their respective officers, officials, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers, affiliated organizations and insurers (collectively, the "Released Parties") from any and **all claims for damage, loss, or injury to myself, other persons, horses or other property belonging to me to the fullest extent** permitted by law that arises out of or relates in any way to the Competition and my participation in the Competition **INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, DAMAGES, LOSS, OR INJURY RESULTING FROM ANY ACTS, FAILURE TO ACT, NEGLIGENCE OR NEGLECT OF OTHER ENTRANTS, THE RELEASED PARTIES, THEIR CONTRACTORS OR INVITEES**, as well as for theft, vandalism, fire, other casualty damage, or damage arising out of any defects in the premises.

I AGREE to indemnify and hold harmless (that is pay all losses, damages, attorneys fees and costs of) the Released Parties from and against any and all claims, demands, penalties, actions, losses, costs, damages, injuries, liabilities and obligations (including attorneys fees) of whatsoever kind and nature, which may be asserted against or incurred by any of them as a result of (1) my participation in the Competition or (2) any act, failure to act, or neglect (a) by me, my agents, employees, riders, handlers, trainers, coaches, drivers, contractors or invitees, or (b) by any animal owned or exhibited by me or in my custody or control.

I AGREE to accept AS FINAL any decision of AHA, the Show Commission or Show Officials concerning my qualification or the qualification of my horse to enter the Competition or any results of the Competition, except to the extent that the Rules of AHA, the Competition, Equestrian Canada or U.S. Equestrian Federation permit a protest or hearing of such decisions. Should a hearing be requested, **I agree to accept AS FINAL** the decision of the particular hearing body. **I agree to release, hold harmless and not to sue** AHA, the Competition Sponsor, their officers, directors, employees, volunteers or members concerning any decision of AHA, the Competition, its Show Commission, Show Officials or any hearing body that relates to my qualifications or my horse(s)' qualifications to enter the Competition or any results of the Competition.

I AGREE that AHA has the sole right to control, sell, supervise or give away (or assign to others the right to do so) the exclusive rights to broadcast, televise, reproduce, transmit and disseminate all or part of this event, and I agree that AHA may use or assign, in any way AHA sees fit, photographs, films, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the Competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the Competition or AHA. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way which implies endorsement of any company, product, product category or service. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.

I AGREE and represent that I am qualified and eligible to enter and/or participate in the Competition and every horse I am entering is qualified and eligible as entered .

I FUTHER AGREE that by participating in an Amateur class that I am in compliance with the USEF Amateur rule.

By signing below as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and agree to all of the above provisions, and further agree to assume all of the obligations of this AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification personally and on behalf of the child.

This AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification is governed by the Laws of the State of Colorado and is intended to be interpreted as broadly as possible.
