SHOW RULES

USEF rules will be used, though not sanctioned by USEF

ENTRIES

- Only one owner per entry form. All fees must accompany entry.
- Entry forms must be signed. Venmo is available.
- Post entry fees will be charged on all entries received AFTER February 2nd, 2025
- Post entries will be accepted until the end of the session prior

ATTIRE & EQUIPMENT

- Schooling riding attire is strongly encouraged, braiding is optional, and long tails may remain in tail bags if exhibitor so desires
- School attire and equipment permitted

HEALTH PAPERS

- Current Coggins and a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (both dated within 1 year of the show) is required; according to 302 KAR 20:065

STABLING & BEDDING

- All stalls will be assigned. No additional hardware and no straw bedding is allowed
- Per a new fairground requirement, bedding MUST be purchased through BHS for the Shelby Country Fairgrounds. Bedding is available at \$12/bag. BHS does not add a surcharge, and all bedding fees go directly to the fairgrounds.

TBA CLASSES

- TBA Class fee is \$50. Contact show manager to discuss availability.

RIBBONS

- Ribbons can be picked up at the show office after results have been received.

GATE CALL

- You are responsible for making it to the ring for your class on time! The gate will not be held unless requested at the show office.
- A two minute maximum gate call will be enforced.
- Late entrants to the ring may be made at the discretion of management.

HEADGEAR

- Protective Headgear is strongly recommended for 18 and under.

DISCIPLINE

- Discipline for acts of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials on the part of the owner, groom, rider, driver or member of the family of the person participating in the show will disqualify the horse from adjudication.

REMOVAL

- Management reserves the right to remove a groom, horse, rider or driver from the show.

DOGS

- Dogs must be leashed at ALL times.

CLASSES & FINAL DECISIONS

- Judge's decisions are FINAL.
- Classes may be split or combined at the discretion of management

ENTRY CANCELLATIONS, REFUNDS, WEATHER, ACTS OF GOD, & EMERGENCIES

- Refunds, except office fees, if horse has a current veterinary note and has been tested for illness
- No refunds for any reason after the closing date of the show
- Management reserves the right to cancel any classes due to hazardous weather, acts of God, accident or emergency

DIVISION & CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

- Individuals are the age they were as of January 1st of the current competition year.
- Leadline exhibitors may not cross enter any other class at the show except Walk/Walk.
- All leadline exhibitors must have saddle and stirrups and be in proper safety riding attire.
- Walk/Walk Walk/Trot horses cannot cross enter W/T/C classes with the same rider - excluding warm up classes.
- Green Horse Classes are for horses or ponies, which are in their first or second year of showing.
- Green Rider is a horseperson which is in their first or second year of showing
- English may include hunter, dressage, sport or saddleseat
- The dosey doe class consists of two riders, one horse! One rider rides first direction then lines up, second rider rides second direction! Costumes are optional.
- The Grooming/Presentation class will be judged on the best turn out/presentation of your horse! This is your time to show off your grooming skills!

NEW for 2025

Per a new Fairground requirement, bedding MUST be purchased from the fairgrounds via BHS.

If you bring in outside bedding, you will be charged as if it was purchased at the show

\$70 - BRONZE B - Includes trailer/gravel fee, office fee, and up to 2 classes

\$125 - SILVER B - Includes trailer/gravel fee, office fee, and 3-6 classes

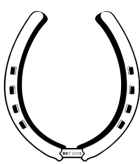
