Show Rules: (USEF rules will be used, though not sanctioned by USEF) Entries: Only one owner per entry form. All fees must accompany entry. Entry forms must be signed. Post entry fees will be charged on all entries posted after the Monday prior to show date. Post entries will be accepted until the end of the session prior. Each competitor is responsible for supplying management with correct copies of registrations and membership numbers before the day of competition. Attire (new): schooling riding attire is strongly encouraged, braiding is optional, and long tails may remain in tail bags Current Coggins and a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (both dated within 1 year of the show) is required; according to 302 KAR 20:065. Stabling: All stalls will be assigned. No additional hardware and no straw bedding. TBA Classes: Any class not offered in this show and listed on the standard class list. Ribbons: can be picked up at the show office after results have been received. Gate Call: You are responsible for making it to the ring for your class on time. The Gate will not be held unless requested at the show office. Late entrants to the ring may be made at the discretion of management. Judge's decisions are FINAL.

Classes: may be split or combined at the discretion of management. Discipline: for acts of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials on the part of the owner, groom, rider, driver or member of the family of the person participating in the show will disqualify the horse from adjudication. Management reserves the right to remove a groom, horse, rider or driver from the show. School attire and equipment permitted. Headgear: Protective Headgear is strongly recommended. Dogs must be leashed at ALL times. Division & Class Specifications: Age of Exhibitors: Individuals are the age they were as of January 1st of the current competition year. Leadline: Leadliners may not cross enter any other class at the show except Walk/Walk. All leadliners must have saddle and stirrups and be in proper safety riding attire. Walk/Walk/Trot Classes: Walk/Walk Walk/Trot horses cannot cross enter W/T/C classes with the same rider - excluding warm up classes. Green Horse Classes are for horses or ponies, which are in their first or second year of showing. Green Rider is a horseperson which is in their first or second year of showing.

BLUEGRASS HORSE SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

- USEF rules will be used, though not sanctioned by USEF, every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance
- Entries: Only one owner per entry form. All fees must accompany entry. Entry forms must be signed. Post entry fees will be charged on all entries posted after the Saturday prior to show date. Post entries will be accepted until the end of the session prior. Each competitor is responsible for supplying management with correct copies of registrations and membership numbers before the day of competition.
- <u>Classes</u>: may be split or combined at the discretion of management
- <u>Gate Call:</u> You are responsible for making it to the ring for your class on time. The gate will be be held unless *requested at the show office*. All participants must be listening and be on time. Late entrants to the ring may be made at the discretion of management. **Judge's** decisions are **FINAL**. **Gate holds:** are 2 minutes max
- TBA Classes: any class not offered in this show and listed on the standard class list. Please contact show secretary and show manager to add TBA
- <u>Division & Class Specifications:</u> Age of Exhibitors: individuals are the age they were as of December 1st of the previous year
- <u>Leadline:</u> leadliners may not cross enter any other class at the show except walk/walk. All leadliners must have saddle and stirrups and be in proper safety riding attire
 - o <u>Walk/Walk/Trot Classes:</u> walk/walk/trot horses cannot cross enter W/T/C classes with the same rider excluding warm up classes
 - o Green Horse Classes: for horses or ponies, which are in their first or second year of showing
 - o Green Rider/Beginner: horse person which is in their first or second year of showing
 - **Novice:** rider with 3-5 seasons
- Back numbers will be assigned at the show
- **Ribbons:** can be picked up at show office after results have been received
- <u>Stabling:</u> all stalls will be assigned. No additional hardware and no straw bedding. Bedding can be ordered. Must fill out a stable request form to stable together with another barn.
- **Discipline:** for acts of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials on the part of the owner, groom, rider, driver or member of the family of the person participating in the show will disqualify the horse from adjudication. Management reserves the right to remove any aforementioned persons.
- Entry Cancellation/Refunds/Hazardous Weather/Acts of God/Emergencies: refund (except office fee) will be given only if submitted in writing either by mail or email prior to or on the closing date. No refunds for any reason after closing date unless you can find someone to take all your exact rides and ride times, then if so, entire entry fees minus office fee will be refunded. Management reserves the right to cancel any classes due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, accident, or emergency. Every effort will be made to reschedule. No refunds for cancellations due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, accidents, or emergencies.
- <u>Current Coggins</u> and a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (both dated within 1 year of the show) is required; according to 302 KAR 20:065
